

NOTICE OF PERMIT HEARINGS

PRAIRIELANDS GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT To be held 9:00 AM, Monday, December 21, 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons within the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District, consisting of Ellis, Hill, Johnson, and Somervell counties: That the Board of Directors of the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District (PGCD) will hold hearing(s) on applications for Operating Permits (OP) by the below listed parties on Monday, December 21, 2020, beginning at 9:00 AM at the District board room located at 208 Kimberly Dr., Cleburne, Texas 76301.

NOTICE is hereby specifically given to:

- 1. Monarch Utilities (Triple H Estates), for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well not to exceed 1 MG for 2020, and 5 MG annually thereafter; 1822 Hudson Court, Alvarado, Texas; Johnson County; Municipal Use;
- 2. Joe Sonntag, for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well not to exceed 864,000 gallons for 2020, and 9.5 MG annually thereafter; 1258 County Road 300, Rainbow, Texas; Somervell County; Commercial Use for sand and gravel mining;
- 3. Owen Oil Tools (a division of Core Laboratories) for a proposed Operating Permit for existing wells not to exceed 400,000 gallons annually; 12001 County Road 1000, Godley, Texas; Johnson County; Industrial Manufacturing/Public Water; and
- 4. Woodrow Osceola WSC, for a proposed Operating Permit for existing wells not to exceed 5 MG for 2020, and 15 MG annually thereafter; 1147 FM 934, Blum, Texas; Hill County; Municipal Use.

If granted, the permit(s) requested in the applications above would authorize the permit holder to withdraw groundwater from a water well according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit. If you would like to contest an application for a permit, you must comply with District Rule 10.6 and either appear at the hearing or submit a written Request for Contested Case Hearing that complies with District Rule 10.6 and that must be received by the District prior to the date of the hearing. A person who submits a written Request for Contested Case Hearing who is unable to appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above must also timely file a motion for continuance with PGCD demonstrating good cause for the inability to appear.
