NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons within the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District, consisting of Ellis, Hill, Johnson, and Somervell counties: That the Board of Directors of the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District (PGCD) will hold hearing(s) on applications for Operating Permits (OP) by the below listed parties on Monday, October 18, 2021, beginning at 9:00 AM at the District board room located at 208 Kimberly Drive, Cleburne, Texas 76031.

NOTICE is hereby specifically given to:

1. Monarch Utilities (Crowley 1 Acre Sky Corp Water), for a proposed Operating Permit for a new well (#2588) to be drilled in Johnson County at 5712 Texas Street, Joshua, Texas 76126; not to exceed 20,000,000 gallons annually for 2022→2026; Municipal use (Driller of record: Watts Drilling)
2. United Production Partners, LLC (Scottie Dog), for a proposed Operating Permit for additional groundwater production authorization in Johnson County at 6692 North FM 157, Venus, Texas 76084; not to exceed 50,000 annually for 2021→2026; Industrial use
3. Fleur De Lis Energy, LLC (William David), for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well (#2520) located in Johnson County at 3900 County Road 405, Alvarado, Texas 76009; not to exceed 9,000,000 gallons annually for 2021→2026; Oil and gas operation (fracking)
4. Fleur De Lis Energy, LLC (Bill West), for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well (#2538) located in Johnson County at 6833 FM 2415, Grandview, Texas 76050; not to exceed 9,000,000 gallons annually for 2021→2026; Oil and gas operation (fracking)

If granted, the permit(s) requested in the applications above would authorize the permit holder to withdraw groundwater from a water well according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit. If you would like to contest an application for a permit, you must comply with District Rule 10.6 and either appear at the hearing or submit a written Request for Contested Case Hearing that complies with District Rule 10.6 and that must be received by the District prior to the date of the hearing. A person who submits a written Request for Contested Case Hearing who is unable to appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above must also timely file a motion for continuance with PGCD demonstrating good cause for the inability to appear.
