## MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON APPLICATION FOR OPERATING PERMIT

The Board of Directors of the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District ("District") met in special session, open to the public, within the boundaries of the District at 208 Kimberly Dr, Cleburne, TX, on October 18, 2021.

President Charles Beseda presided and called the public hearing to order at 12:37 p.m., announcing the meeting open to the public.

The roll was called of the members of the Board of Directors, to wit:

All members of the Board were in attendance, with the exception of Director Daniels, thus constituting a quorum of the Board of Directors. Also attending said meeting were Kathy Turner Jones, General Manager; Brian Sledge, General Counsel; District staff; and members of the public. Copies of the public sign-in sheets are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to the October 18, 2021 Regular Board Meeting minutes.

RECEIVE PUBLIC HEARING REPORT FROM GENERAL MANAGER, ANY PUBLIC COMMENT(S), REQUESTS TO CONTEST AND CONSIDER GRANTING, DENYING, OR AMENDING APPLICATIONS FOR THE FOLLOWING APPLICATION FOR OPERATING PERMIT(S)

1) Monarch Utilities (Crowley 1 Acre Sky Corp Water), for a proposed Operating Permit for a new well (#2588) to be drilled in Johnson County at 5712 Texas Street, Joshua, Texas 76126; not to exceed 20,000,000 gallons annually; Municipal Use. (Driller of record: Watts Drilling). Ms. Jones stated the applicant is requesting an Operating Permit to drill and operate a new non-exempt well within their proposed CCN in Johnson County to provide water for public water supply to the Crowley 1 Acre Sky Corp subdivision not to exceed 20,000,000 gallons annually for 2022 through 2026. Director Kirk made a motion to approve the application for an Operating Permit. Director Osborn seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

- 2) United Production Partners, LLC (Scottie Dog), for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well (#345) located in Johnson County at 1102 NE Barnard Street, Glen Rose, Texas 76043; not to exceed 50,000 annually; Industrial use. Ms. Jones reported the applicant is requesting an Operating Permit for additional groundwater production authorization of 50,000 gallons annually for 2021 through 2026. She added the applicant submitted an application for a Historic Use Permit (HUP-220) on August 19, 2019 for one existing well, Well ID 345, with a maximum historic use claim of 16,120 gallons based on metered production reported to the District in 2012 and there are no other wells within the contiguous controlled acreage. Director McClure made a motion to approve the application for an Operating Permit. Director Osborn seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
- 3) Fleur De Lis Energy, LLC (William David), for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well (#2520) located in Johnson County at 3900 County Road 405, Alvarado, Texas 76009; not to exceed 9,000,000 gallons annually for 2021 → 2026; Oil and gas operation (fracking). By request of the applicant, no action was taken on this application, and it would instead be listed for consideration at a public hearing coinciding with the November 15, 2021 board of directors meeting.
- 4) Fleur De Lis Energy, LLC (Bill West), for a proposed Operating Permit for an existing well (#2538) located in Johnson County at 6833 FM 2415, Grandview, Texas 76050; not to exceed 9,000,000 gallons annually for 2021→2026; Oil and gas operation (fracking). By request of the applicant, no action was taken on this application, and it would instead be listed for consideration at a public hearing coinciding with the November 15, 2021 board of directors meeting.

There being no further discussion, Director Osborn made a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Director McPherson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. The public hearing was adjourned at 12:43 p.m.
