

NOTICE OF PERMIT HEARINGS

PRAIRIELANDS GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT To be held 9:00 AM, Monday, August 21, 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons within the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District, consisting of Ellis, Hill, Johnson, and Somervell counties: That the Board of Directors of the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District (PGCD) will hold hearing(s) on applications for Operating Permits (OP) by the below listed parties on Monday, August 21, 2023, beginning at 9:00 AM at the District board room located at 208 Kimberly Drive, Cleburne, Texas 76031.

NOTICE is hereby specifically given to:

- 1. TPWD Cleburne State Park, for a proposed Operating Permit (OP-23-043) for additional groundwater production authorization in Johnson County at 5800 Park Rd 21, Cleburne, TX; not to exceed 1,000,000 gallons annually for 2023→2027; Recreational/Public Water System (KB)
- 2. Morgan Acres LLC, for a proposed Operating Permit (OP-23-045) for authorization to drill a new well (PGCD-003232) to be located in Johnson County at 1008 Highland Road, Cleburne, TX; not to exceed 1,406,200 gallons annually for 2023→2027; Commercial/Public Water System (KB)
- 3. CLDVM LLC, for a proposed Operating Permit (OP-23-044) for authorization to drill a new well (PGCD-003219) to be located in Hill County at 1545 I-35, Abbott, TX; not to exceed 1,177,750 gallons in 2023 and 4,711,000 gallons annually for 2024→2027; Commercial/Public Water System (AK)

If granted, the permit(s) requested in the applications above would authorize the permit holder to withdraw groundwater from a water well according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit. If you would like to contest an application for a permit, you must comply with District Rule 10.6 and either appear at the hearing or submit a written Request for Contested Case Hearing that complies with District Rule 10.6 and that must be received by the District prior to the date of the hearing. A person who submits a written Request for Contested Case Hearing who is unable to appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above must also timely file a motion for continuance with PGCD demonstrating good cause for the inability to appear.
